OFFICIAL SEVENTH-DAY ADVENTIST BAPTISMAL VOWS

Seventh-day Adventists do not believe in baptising infants. A person must be old enough to accept responsibility for his/her own actions. Baptism is by immersion. In order to be baptised, a person must agree to this set of thirteen baptismal vows:
